We do when we are doing a regular NCOWS event. Our events fall under the following guidelines:

The time period is from 1836 to 1890. Black powder is the only recognized gunpowder. No substitutes allowed. All firearms and accouterments must fall within the time period. Duelist is the only shooting stance unless a physical handicap prevents it. Timers are not used; scoring is misses and procedurals. Categories are duelist and Pistoleer, which is cap and ball revolver and pre-1873 rifle and mule-eared shotgun. This is just an introduction, come and join the fun! The Extravaganza is the next scheduled event, but who knows we may do more!
